• Wear **long pants or skirts and covered shoulders**, especially when inside temples.

OBSERVE AND FOLLOW LOCAL CUSTOMS

- If you want to participate in offerings, follow what locals do and be **mindful of Buddhist etiquette**.
- Remove shoes before entering temple areas.

KEEP A RESPECTFUL DISTANCE

• During the **ordination ceremony (Day 3)**, avoid disrupting monks and families with flash photography or loud noises.
